Stripping guide: CFRC 10 mm Agate-Jade
Upper guides: Chrome Snake guides and tip

Other: Chrome hook keeper, aluminum knurled winding check

Main wrap thread: Hitena Translucent Nylon thread, #434 Pinetree Accent threads: Sulky Metallic-Red 142-7014 White 7022 Blue 7016

Epoxy: Flex Coat Light-2 coats
